### **Religion**

The Religious Education units of work covered this term will focus on the following topics:

- Reconciliation
- Confirmation

### **English**

In English students will further develop their literacy skills and focus on:

- Reading and writing CVC words
- Reading and writing high frequency words
- Writing a short sentence using knowledge of letters and sounds, capital letters, spacing and full stops
- Reading short sentences using knowledge of letters and sounds and high frequency words
- Orally retelling and creating a narrative story

### **Mathematics**

In Mathematics students will further develop their numeracy skills and focus on:

#### **Number**

- Solving simple addition sums
- Orally counting to and from 20
- Writing numbers to 20 using correct formations
- Match number names, numerals and quantities
- Representing a number in multiple ways

#### **Measurement & Geometry**

- Ordering events using everyday language
- Comparing and order objects by length and weight
- Recognising and sorting 3D objects

### **History**

In History students will focus on:

- Exploring stories from the past and understanding that they can be passed down through generations
- Exploring artefacts from the past and developing an understanding of how they tell us a story
- Exploring various celebrations and identifying how different people celebrate them

### **Science**

In Science students will focus on:

- Identifying the basic needs living things require to survive

### **Health**

In Health students will complete Keeping Safe Child Protection program
