### Religion

The Religious Education units of work covered this term will focus on the following topics:

- Baptism
- Advent

### English

In English students will further develop their literacy skills and focus on:

- Reading and writing CVC words
- Reading and writing high frequency words
- Writing a short sentence using knowledge of letters and sounds, capital letters, spacing and full stops
- Reading short sentences using knowledge of letters and sounds and high frequency words
- Orally retelling and creating a narrative story

### Mathematics

In Mathematics students will further develop their numeracy skills and focus on:

#### **Number**

- Counting to 20 and beyond
- Writing numbers to 20 and beyond
- Subitising
- Comparing, ordering and making correspondence between collections
- Solving simple addition sums
- Matching number names, numerals and quantities

#### **Measurement & Geometry**

- Following spatial directions
- Following position and movement instructions

#### **Statistics and Probability**

- Answering yes and no questions to collect information

### Science

In Science students will focus on:

- Exploring materials and their observable properties

### Health

In Health students will continue with the Keeping Safe Child Protection program.
