



## Pre-Primary Curriculum Term One, 2022

Dear Parents/Caregivers,

This term in Pre-Primary we will be exploring various topics and learning lots of new skills. Please see below for further information regarding the topics and skills being taught in each learning area.

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### Religion

The Religious Education units of work covered this term will focus on the following topics:

- Church – This unit focuses on how everyone is unique and that Jesus loves all people. It also explores how God's family is called the Church and that people in God's family make the sign of the cross.
- Lent/ Easter – This unit focuses on the concept of new life and explores how the Church celebrates new life.

### English

In English students will develop their literacy skills and focus on:

- Recognising and pronouncing common sounds
- Writing the letters of the alphabet using correct formations
- Writing their name using correct formations
- Identifying the initial sound in a word
- Orally blending at a compound word, onset and rime and three letter word level
- Orally segmenting the sounds in a three letter word
- Orally retelling and sequencing stories

### Mathematics

In Mathematics students will develop their numeracy skills and focus on:

#### **Number**

- Orally counting to and from 20
- Writing numbers to 10 using correct formations
- Matching number names, numerals and quantities
- Representing a number in multiple ways
- Counting and creating different amounts of objects using one-to-one correspondence

#### **Measurement & Geometry**

- Copying, continuing and creating a simple pattern
- Sorting various objects according to their features

### Science

In Science students will focus on:

- Identifying how their body moves in different ways

### Health

In Health students will complete the PATHS program. The PATHS program explores the various emotions and how to manage these emotions in different situations.
