If your child is going to be absent from school, parents are asked to ring the Absentee Line on **9294 5535** by 8.30am on the day of absence and leave the following information:

- Full Name of Student
- Year/Class (eg 1G)
- Reason for absence and expected length of absence
- Your name and relationship to the student

As part of our school's duty of care, if you have not notified the school office or your child's class teacher of their absence, you will be notified via an SMS that your child has been recorded as being absent. On receipt of the SMS, please contact the school office to confirm their absence. **All** absences will need to be followed up with a written note to the OFFICE, or an email sent to [admin@stanthonygreen.wa.edu.au](mailto:admin@stanthonygreen.wa.edu.au)

***All absences require a written explanation for auditing purposes.***

### LATE ARRIVALS

If your child is arriving late to school, they are required to be signed in at the school office by the parent/carer.

### STUDENT APPOINTMENTS

Children who need to leave the school during school hours (eg: for appointments with doctor, dentist etc) need to be signed out at the school office by the parent/carer and then signed in when they return to school from their appointment.

## Ash Wednesday – Commencement of Lent



On Ash Wednesday our Year 5B lead the classes in Years 4-6 in a Virtual Mass to commence lent. Ash Wednesday opens Lent, a season of fasting and prayer. Ash Wednesday comes from the ancient Jewish tradition of penance and fasting. The practice includes the wearing of ashes on the head. The ashes symbolize the dust from which God made us. Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter. During Lent, we seek the Lord in prayer by reading Sacred Scripture; we serve by giving alms; and we practice self-control through fasting. We are called not only to abstain from luxuries during Lent, but to a true inner conversion of heart as we seek to follow Christ's will more faithfully. We recall the waters of baptism in which we were also baptized into Christ's death, died to sin and evil, and began new life in Christ.

## RECYCLING PROGRAM



**St Anthony's School – Greenmount Collected 136.3 kilos of batteries 2021 and comes second in the large school category!**

The Eastern Metropolitan Regional Council (EMRC) and the Shire of Mundaring would like to extend their congratulations to the students at St Anthony's School – Greenmount for collecting 136.3 kg in 2021, which was 33.2 kilos than the previous year and earning second place in the large school category.

In recognition of your fantastic achievement, St Anthony's School – Greenmount have been awarded the following prize:

Rezap pro reusable battery charger + organiser and tester - Battery charger that extends the life of your batteries, you save money and reduce the impact on your environment. You can recharge up to four AAA, AA, C, D and 9V type cells at the same time. Convenient battery organiser for easy storage and removable tester to make sure batteries are ready to use.

Batteries contain recyclable elements including carbon, zinc, manganese, lithium, nickel, copper and aluminium. They also contain hazardous materials which can pollute groundwater and soil. And yet, 94% of batteries are still disposed of in household rubbish bins.

The EMRC Battery Collection Program began in 2003, and has grown from just 5 schools participating, to 100 across the region. Since 2005, more than 180 tonnes of household batteries have been diverted from landfill. St Anthony's School – Greenmount joined the program in 2020 and have diverted 239.4 kgs of batteries.

Reminder - You can bring in the following batteries for recycling:

- Button batteries
- AA and AAA batteries
- C and D batteries
- 6V and 9V batteries

## SCHOOL PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT AFTER HOURS

At the present time, children are playing on the school playground equipment after school. The school is considered private property and as the Principal of the school I am responsible for the welfare of any person on school premises. Under our Public Liability Insurance, there is a duty of care to provide a safe environment. If the school foresees possible problems, or potential claims, it is a condition under our Public Liability Policy to take "reasonable care and precautions to prevent personal injury and/or property damage." If this reasoning is applied to the use of our playground equipment outside school hours, there is a cause for concern. I have been advised by Catholic Church Insurance to ban all children from playing on school playground equipment outside school hours even if parents or guardians are present.
