Belonging

At St Anthony's School we want to feel a sense of belonging

Respected

In order for everyone to feel **respected**, we all need to:

- care for one another
- look at and listen to the person speaking
- take turns at speaking
- acknowledge any differences of opinions
- be willing to negotiate and compromise
- speak kindly to one another
- play fairly

Safe

At St Anthony's School we want to feel safe.

In order for everyone to feel safe, we all need to:

- follow school rules
- look after each other
- follow emergency procedures
- use equipment respectfully and safely
- inform teachers if someone isn't doing the right thing
- remind each other of the school rules
- inform teachers if something in the natural environment is not safe e.g. a loose brick.
